



2023 Conditions of Entry

“Organising Body” referred to in this document is Australian International Pedal Prix Inc. (AIPP)
“Event/s” referred to in this document is any one of the events, or combination thereof, which make up the UniSA Australian HPV Super Series and any other stand-alone events conducted by AIPP.

1 It is acknowledged that –

- 1.1 Registrations will be accepted into each Round as follows:
Round 1 – 120 teams
Round 2 – 180 teams
Round 3
 - Junior School and Community (S1 & C4) – 120 teams
 - Middle & Senior School (S2 & S3) – 120 teams
 - Community (C5, C6 & C7) – 120 teamsRound 4 – 175 teams
Round 5 – 100 teams
Round 6
 - Middle & Senior School (S2 & S3), Community (C5, C6 & C7) – 165 teams,
Primary School (S1) - 10 teams
- 1.2 Teams not accepted within the limits for each round will be placed on a waiting list in the order they are received. Wait listed teams are not required to pay entry fees until they are elevated from the waiting list.
- 1.3 The waiting list will be reviewed by AIPP Inc as and when appropriate
- 1.4 AIPP has the right to refuse/revoke an entry from any team/team member without further explanation.
- 1.5 Teams may participate in any number of events however if registrations exceed the limit in any event preference will be given to teams who have registered to compete in the Series.
- 1.6 Teams planning to compete at Murray Bridge Round 6 must compete in at least 2 short duration events conducted by AIPP in 2023.

2 I have read and understood the Series Information document on the AIPP web site and that I will ensure all members (and/or their legal Guardian where required) have read and understood all relevant Rules and Specifications issued for each event and agree to be bound by them.

3 It is understood that this entry is for event/s that involves participation by Teams in competition to race the vehicle they have entered against others on a closed, supervised and safety-controlled circuit designated by the Organising Body. Such competition will be

between two or more human powered vehicles (governed by the use of relevant construction specifications and competition rules) running simultaneously on the same course and in which the determining factor is the vehicle that has travelled the greatest number of laps in the allotted time.

- 4 In exchange for being able to attend or participate in these events, I/the team members (and/or their legal guardians where appropriate) declare, acknowledge and agree -
 - 4.1 all participants have sufficient experience and competence to participate safely in the event;
 - 4.2 to release, exempt and indemnify Australian International Pedal Prix Inc, promoters, sponsor organisations, land owners and lessees, organisers of the event, their respective servants, officials, representatives and agents (collectively, the "Associated Entities") from all liability for death, personal injury, psychological trauma, loss or damage (including property damage) (collectively known as "Harm") howsoever arising from participation in or attendance at the event, except to the extent prohibited by law;
 - 4.3 Australian International Pedal Prix Inc and the Associated Entities do not make any warranty, implied or express, that the event services will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
 - 4.4 we attend and/or participate at each event at our own risk;
 - 4.5 risks associated with attending or participating in the event include the risk that harm may be suffered as a result of –
 - 4.5.1 human powered vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other human powered vehicles, persons or property;
 - 4.5.2 acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event;
 - 4.5.3 failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure the safety of persons or property at the event;
 - 4.5.4 any form of racing being dangerous and accidents causing harm can and do happen from time to time and may happen to any team member;
 - 4.6 I will abide by any directions given by the Event Director, Race Director, Chief Marshal, their delegates or any official event personnel.
 - 4.7 it will be a requirement that all team members agree to the free use of their name and picture, team name and/or institution/school name which my team represents, in broadcasts, telecasts and the press as they pertain to the event;
 - 4.8 if any action on my part, or on my team's part is deemed by the Organising Body to be in breach of the Series Regulations/Rules and/or specifications, penalties may be applied to myself or the team (which may result in disqualification) at the sole discretion of the Organising Body.
 - 4.9 that the Organising Body may from time to time release team contact information to third party providers associated with the events for the purpose of conveying information relevant to the events to competing teams.

- 5 The Organising Body reserves the right to abandon, cancel, postpone or modify the competition in the case of unforeseen circumstances. It is acknowledged that AIPP Inc will endeavour to provide a comparable event in circumstances where an event is postponed to another date/venue other than that published. In such circumstances, no refund will be made to any Team not be able to participate in the revised event. Full or partial refund of the entry fee for any individual event cancelled may be made depending upon expenditure commitments made by AIPP prior to the event being cancelled.
- 6 On behalf of the Team I am entering acknowledge the right of the Organising Body to make a decision in any case not covered by the various rules / regulations / specifications governing the Series.
- 7 If changes are made to the Series Regulations/Rules and/or specifications or venue of any event in the Series, the event organisers will attempt to notify all affected teams via their email contact. Changes will also be published on the web site.
- 8 A team electing to withdraw from any event more than 21 days prior to the event is entitled to a full refund of fees paid. Withdrawals after this time will be refunded 50% of the entry fee paid unless the withdrawn entry is from an event with a waiting list in which case a 100% refund will be given.
- 9 All team members (or their legal guardian, where appropriate) will be required to individually sign an indemnity document that will reflect the above information and return it with final team information prior to being able to enter the competition.
